

Cairnhill Lodge – Location Details

The lodge is located close to the hamlet of **Kirkton of Glenisla**, which is approximately a 2-hour drive north of either Glasgow and Edinburgh.

Glenisla extends from near the town of Alyth in the south: running northwards into the Cairngorms National Park.

Travelling south on the A9:

1. Exit through Pitlochry, turning left onto A924 (Blairgowrie / Braemar).
2. As you exit Kirkmichael, take a left onto B950 (Braemar).
3. Continue on B950 to T-Junction on A93 and turn left.
4. After 3¼ miles turn right on B951 signed to Glenisla and Kirriemuir.
5. Follow B951 through Kirkton of Glenisla; passing the hotel on the left and continue for another 0.6 miles (caution satnav might not be correct).
6. Look out for a small road leading to the left (Photo 1). It is a sharp turn! Take this small road.
7. Follow road for 0.4 miles – crossing a small bridge and then passing 6 small white cottages on your right side.
8. Cairnhill Lodge is on the right (Photo 2) and opposite the Glenisla Forestry Commission carpark.
9. Please park beside the lodge.

Travelling south on the A93:

- A. About 5 miles south of Spittal of Genshee turn left on B951 signed to Glenisla and Kirriemuir.
- B. Follow directions: from stage 5-9 given previously.

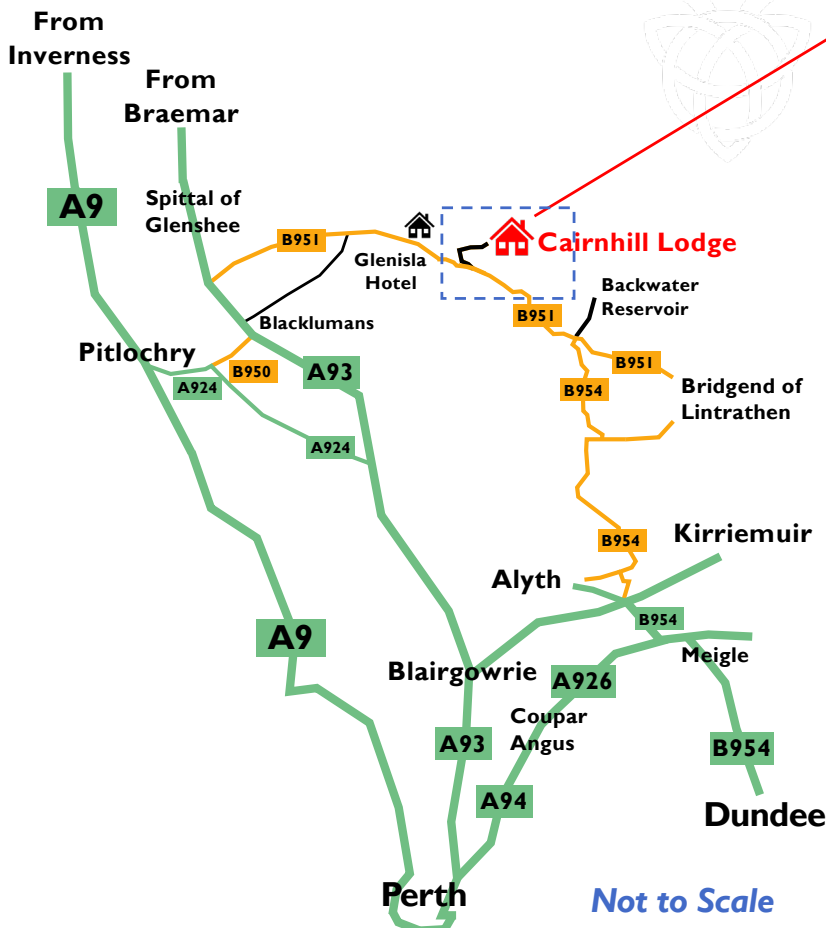


Photo 1: Exit from B951 (Southbound)
